  - ❖ Monitoring each employee in the realization on the set tasks (in case of need, taking corrective action) – Material–technical security for the smooth execution of underwater operations (correct use of diving equipment, tools and machinery on the diving boat ; Ordinary and extraordinary control of safety and maintenance of machinery and diving equipment; Quality inspection and functions serviced or repaired machinery or equipment; Daily monitoring equipment to provide first aid in case of diving incident);
