The **WIIS Poland – NGC* Women Mentoring Program** is addressed to Polish female STEM students who are interested in pursuing their future careers in the defense sector. It aims to empower its participants, build strong new relationships and encourage young females to take an active role in international security. The program was established by Mary Petryszyn, Corporate Vice President and President, Defense System Sector Northrop Grumman Corporation and Prof. Ph.D. Aleksandra Gasztold, Secretary General of the Women In International Security Poland on 19. July 2022 in Warsaw.

The agenda of the **WIIS Poland – NGC Women Mentoring Program** is focused on skip-level networking, experience sharing, enhanced learning and empowerment. This 1 year (12 months) program will feature 10 young women in STEM, including undergraduate and graduate students. Moreover, the project promotes gender equality and diversity.
