Prof.dr Shaul Shay



Senior Research Fellow at INIS – Institute for National and International Security, Research Fellow, ICT and Director of Research, Institute for Policy and Strategy (IPS), Reichman University, Herzliya, Israel Colonel (Res) Dr Shaul Shay served 27 years in the IDF as a paratrooper officer and in the Military Intelligence. In the 1973 war he served as a paratrooper and in the first Lebanon war in 1982 he was the G2 of an armor brigade. In the 1990s he served as the head of counter terror branch and the intelligence officer of the Southern Command. In the years 2000 – 2007 he was the head of the IDF Military History Department. In the years 2007-2009 he was the deputy head of the National Security Council (NSC) of Israel. Shaul Shay holds M.A and Phd degrees from the Bar Ilan University and he is a lecturer in Reichman University. Shaul Shay is the director of research of the Institute for Policy and Strategy and a senior research fellow of the International Policy Institute for counter Terrorism (ICT) at Reichman University, Israel.

Prof.dr Yoni Fighel



Col. (Ret.) Jonathan Fighel – Senior Research Fellow at INIS – Institute for National and International Security and Senior Research scholar at the International Policy Institute for Counter Terrorism also head of “The Prosecuting Terrorism Intelligence Assistance Unit” at ICT and serves as a consultant and expert witness for the USA Department of Justice on Hamas trails, as well to private US based law firms in cases of prosecuting Al Qaeda terrorism. In the past 10 years is a consultant to a US based law firm on the 9/11 civil lawsuit and is leading a research team. His expertise covers the Palestinian Authority, Islamist terror groups (Hams, PIJ, Al-Qaeda, and Jihadi groups), terrorism funding, Palestinian terrorism and the Palestinian suicide terrorism phenomenon, which he has studied in both academic and governmental frameworks in Israel. Col. Fighel knowledge and first-hand experience combines academic and operational knowledge in counter terrorism, Islam, Arab culture, radical Islam groups and ideology, fluent in Arabic language. In recent years his research deals with Global Jihad, suicide terrorism, radicalization and “home-grown terrorism”, the Internet as a tool for propaganda, recruitment and fundraising. He is also a member of the International Academic Counter Terrorism Community (ICTAC). A media commentator on security issues and counter-terrorism, he has lectured in a number of universities and law enforcement agencies around the world, including the US, India,

Italy, Singapore, Turkey, Australia, Spain and Germany. He has also studied the use of the Internet and a tool for propaganda, recruitment fundraising, and as a radicalization catalyst regarding the “home-grown” terrorism phenomenon. Col. Fighel has published numerous of academic research articles based on analysis and research of primary sources which are being quoted in other academic research and books worldwide.

Col. Fighel served in various operational and field posts of intelligence collection units and research departments at the IDF Intelligence Corps, and as the director’s assistant of the IDF intelligence Production Division. During the 1990’s, Col. Fighel was a member of the steering committee for the implementation of the Oslo Accords and the transfer of powers to the Palestinian Authority. He was also active in obtaining donations from international NGO’s and agencies for the establishment of joint Israeli-Palestinian industrial parks. Col. Fighel is frequently invited for lectures and orientation courses in IDF, Israel National Police, The Border Police, Israeli Security Agency (ISA), FBI, N.Y Police, TSA, Scotland Yard, London police and NATO- COE-DAT center of excellence defence against terrorism in Turkey. Since 2005 Col.Fighel is a permanent lecturer at The Counter-Terrorism Studies Program, offered by the Lauder School of Government, Diplomacy and Strategy and the Institute for Counter-Terrorism (ICT), at the Interdisciplinary Center (IDC) Herzliya.

The Israeli Defense Minister appoints him as a member of academic and governmental research teams on Palestinian suicide bombers and was a consulting member of the Minister of Transportation’s advisory team. Col. Fighel, holds a M.A. in Middle Eastern Studies from Tel Aviv University, as well as a teaching diploma, and is a graduate of the IDF Command and Headquarters School. He has been active in many pro bono educational projects, including the establishment and management of the Middle Eastern Studies Department at the Alon High School in the city of Ramat HaSharon.

Col.(res) Shlomo Mofaz



Shlomo Mofaz is Director of the Meir Amit Intelligence and Terrorism Information Center (ITIC) (<https://www.terrorism-info.org.il/en/>) and Senior Research Fellow at INIS – Institute for National and International Security. He is an expert and researcher in intelligence and counter-terrorism. A retired colonel from Israeli Defense Forces’ (IDF) Military Intelligence (MI), he has a diverse background as an intelligence officer. His has practical, operative and academic experience in intelligence and counter terrorism, research, risk and threat assessment, strategic consulting and project management. Mr. Mofaz has a BA in Middle East history; an MA in political science and is a PhD candidate in political science.

Prof.dr Zoran Dragisic



Zoran Dragišić is full professor and vice dean for development on Faculty of Security Studies – University of Belgrade. He has served in the National Assembly of Serbia since 2016 as part of the parliamentary grouping of the Serbian Progressive Party (Srpska napredna stranka; SNS). He was previously a candidate for president of Serbia in the 2012 presidential election. He graduated from the University of Belgrade Faculty of Security Studies in 1991 as valedictorian and subsequently earned a master's degree (1999) and Ph.D. (2004) from the university's law faculty. Dragišić was a founding member of Vuk Obradović's Social Democracy (Socijaldemokratija; SD) party. This party eventually became divided and factionalized, and in January 2008 Dragišić established a breakaway group called the Independent Social Democrats (Nezavisni Socijaldemokrata, NSD). In August 2009, Dragišić merged the NSD into the newly formed Social Democratic Party of Serbia (Socijaldemokratska partija Srbije; SDPS) led by Rasim Ljajić. In October 2011 he was chosen as leader of a new group called the Movement of Workers and Peasants of Serbia (Pokret radnika i seljaka; PRS). He is currently a member of the parliamentary defence and internal affairs committee; a deputy member of three other committees; a deputy member of Serbia's delegation to the NATO Parliamentary Assembly; the head of the parliamentary friendship group with Turkey; and a member of the parliamentary friendship groups with China, Israel, Syria, the United Kingdom, and the United States of America.

Prof.dr Darko Trifunovic



Prof. dr Darko Trifunovic is a full-time professor in research and he is a founding member and Director of the Institute for National and International Security. Dr. Trifunovic is Editor in Chief of the "Security Science Journal". Dr. Trifunovic was elected as a guest professor at FUDAN University – Center of American Studies, Shanghai, China. Dr. Darko Trifunovic is a Research Professor in the rank of Associate professor at FUDAN University Institute of BRI Strategy and International Security. Dr. Trifunovic is an Adjunct Professor at the Shanghai Academy of Social Science, Coordinator for Research. Dr. Darko Trifunovic is fully employed at the Faculty of Security Studies-University of Belgrade. Prof. dr Darko Trifunovic is a guest professor at Matej Bel University, Faculty of Political Science, Slovakia, and a Senior Researcher at Bar-Ilan University, Israel. He is Senior Advisor at the Research Institute for European and American Studies, Greece, Athens. He is a specialist in Security Studies, Intelligence & Counter-Intelligence studies as well as

Counter-Terrorism, National, and International Security studies. He is a former diplomat (First Secretary of the Foreign Service of Bosnia and Herzegovina at the United Nations). Dr. Trifunovic was the official delegate in Rome in 1998 during the diplomatic conference when International Criminal Court was established. Dr. Trifunovic is the representative for Serbia and Montenegro of the International Strategic Studies Association (ISSA); Defense & Foreign Affairs publications; and the Global Information System. The Shanghai Center for International Studies appointed him as the first foreign expert for the Olympic Games (2008) security preparation in China. In 2010, he is engaged in World Expo Security preparation. Prof. dr Darko Trifunovic is one of the founding members of the International Counter-Terrorism Academic Community (ICTAC). He has published many academic books papers and articles.
